

PUNJAB STATE VETERINARY COUNCIL

INFORMATION UNDER SECTION 4(1) b) OF CHAPTER II OF RIGHT TO INFORMATION ACT

(i) THE PARTICULARS OF ITS ORGANISATION, FUNCTION AND DUTIES;

(a) ORGANISATION

Punjab Veterinary Council was established under the Punjab Veterinary Council Act 1981. The first adhoc Council came into existence during the year 1983 and thereafter the State Council continued to be constituted as per the State Act till the year 1993.

Punjab Vidhan Sabha through an unanimous resolution extended the Indian Veterinary Council Act,1984 to the State of Punjab and repealed the said Act. It was on 4th of May 1994 that Gazette Notification was issued by the Govt. of India in this behalf and this Act of Parliament thus extended to the State of Punjab as well. Thereafter, the Punjab State Veterinary Council was constituted under the Central Act and the Notification to the effect is being issued by the State Government as per provisions in the said Act.

(b) FUNCTION AND DUTIES

Indian Veterinary Council Act, 1984 is an Act to regulate veterinary practice and to provide, for that purpose, for the establishment of a Veterinary Council of India and State Veterinary Councils and the maintenance of registers of the veterinary practitioners and for matter connected therewith.
